

2010 Terms & Conditions for Season Pass Installment Option

By selecting to payment by the installment option, the customer hereby agrees to Treble Cone Investments Ltd (Treble Cone) automatically charging the customer's credit card in three equal installments. The first installment will be charged at the time of purchase and the remaining two installments on the following dates:

Installment two: 30 April 2010

Installment three: 28 May 2010

For choosing to pay by installment, the customer will be charged a credit fee of \$40 per adult pass and \$60 per family pass. (Paid at the same time as the first installment)

Installment option only available with the online purchase of Family season pass, Family Mountain package or Adult unlimited season pass. (Early Bird sales only -ends 31st march 2010)

Default of payment

If any installment is not completed, e.g. due to the credit card payment being declined or reversed), Treble Cone reserves the right to charge a default administration fee of \$50 per card transaction.

Any changes to credit card details must be advised to Treble Cone by email (seasonpasses@treblecone.com) or by telephone (+64 3 443 7443) at least five working days prior to the installment due date. This includes notification of new card expiry dates.

Treble Cone will not be responsible for failure by the customer to make payment on the due date for any reason.

Cancellations and refunds

Season Passes purchased by installment are subject to our full terms and conditions from the date of the first installment (regardless of whether part of full payment has been received). All Season passes are non-transferable

Subject to any rights you may have pursuant to the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 and otherwise under the law there will be no refunds on season passes except in the following cases: (a) The ski area does not open for the 2010 season or (b) You suffer an injury prior to the opening of the ski area. A written application with a supporting medical certificate and the season pass card if already issued should be forwarded to Treble Cone no later than 11th July 2010. All refunds will incur a 10% administration fee. All refunds are at the discretion of Treble Cone Management.

Any refund granted to passes purchased via the Installment Plan will be issued less any credit or administration fees incurred as outlined above.

Issue and collection of season passes

No season pass will be issued or available for collection until full payment of all three installments has been received. (In the case of Family Passes, no member of the family will have their pass issued until the pass has been paid for in full.)
