

## 2010 Programme Outline

On the morning of your trip, call the Snow phone on 03 443 7444 or visit [www.treblecone.com](http://www.treblecone.com) for an updated report on weather and conditions. Please leave a message (if calling before 8.00am) if there are any last minute changes to your group.

Our school programme starts at 9.00am; we do ask that all our groups arrive on the mountain by 8.00am to ensure sufficient time to be fitted in a rentals department.

To make your day as smooth as possible we will have our mountain host meet you on arrival at Treble Cone and guide you and your group through the preparations for the day. Our hosts as qualified instructors will be able to help with any question you may have about the day ahead. First you will be taken to ticket collection and then through to rentals where your group will be fitted out ready for the morning lesson. They will then escort you to the meeting area and leave you in the capable hands of your instructors for the morning.

First stop is the ticket office, please bring with you a copy of your booking form with any last minute changes on the day, our friendly staff will confirm numbers and final cost. Payment can be made by school cheque, eftpos or by any major credit card. You will then be issued with your tickets before heading over to the Rentals Department.

The rentals team will have fitted out as much equipment as possible from the details you provided on our Rental Booking Form. The more information you can give us in advance, the quicker and smoother this process will be. Your Mountain Host and our Rentals team will help to fit equipment and coordinate the group. Please be aware that you may not be the only school visiting Treble Cone and rentals can get extremely busy.

Lessons leave the meeting area at 9.00am and last for 1.25 hours. We aim to have all groups ready to meet their instructors at 8.45am. This way the instructors can chat to your students and organise the groups by ability and learning focus. We have the highest qualified Snow Sports School in NZ and are also able to offer NZQA standard assessments too.

Lesson sizes are no more than 10 students in a single class, with our uncrowded slopes, lift queue priority in lesson time and these smaller class sizes, learning time will be maximised. We recognise the hard work required in bringing a group to Treble Cone and are very pleased to offer the same fantastic rates to those additional helpers that give up their time to help make the trips such a success.

Lessons finish at 10.15am and the group is then free to practice what they have just learnt and to enjoy all the varied terrain and facilities Treble Cone has to offer. On Thursdays we hold our Snow Sports mini world cup, and our school groups are welcome to join in.

### **FREE ORIENTATION DAY**

For those interested in booking their school at Treble Cone we offer a free Orientation day for up to two teachers to join us for a day at Treble Cone.

This gives you an opportunity to learn first hand about our schools skiing programme, and includes all you need for a day on the snow; lift pass, rental equipment, group lesson and a Mountain Tour. Our School Group Coordinator will introduce you to some of the people that will work with you and your school group and will be there to answer your questions and offer hints on how to get the most out of your day
